Policy Change

The ACV Board has run into some misunderstandings when it comes to scrimmage credits and we are proposing the following changes to clarify the policy.

As required by the bylaws, we are notifying all members of the proposed changes which will be voted on at the August General Membership Meeting.

If you have any questions prior to the discussion at the General Membership Meeting, please contact your At-Large-Rep. A separate email will be sent to all members in July with information on voting and these proposed changes will be posted to website.

Proposed Policy Change

G. Scrimmage Credit

A credit may be issued at the end of the season to go toward the following season's dues. Credit will be issued based upon the number of scrimmage hours worked. The amount of credit will be determined by the Board based upon total scrimmage hours worked, scrimmage fees received and Chapter training costs.

Scrimmage hours are defined as those hours worked at a site where the school pays fees directly to Austin Chapter Volleyball during a select timeframe preceding the start of the regular season as determined by UIL.

Please note - Summer League and other pre-season training sessions are not included when determining scrimmage credits, however they are counted toward the annual chapter training requirements, if approved in advance by the

board. Any other designated training sessions completed during the regular season that a member must complete as a make up for scrimmage hours are also not included, however they too will count towards the annual chapter training requirements. Members must stay current on assigning fees owed in order to be eligible to receive any earned scrimmage credit. Chapter dues must be paid prior to a date determined by the board to receive credit.

Current Policy

G. Scrimmage Credit

A credit may be issued at the end of the season to go toward the following season's dues. Credit will be issued based upon the number of scrimmage hours worked in excess of three (3) hours. The amount of credit will be determined by the Board based upon total scrimmage hours worked, scrimmage fees received and Chapter training costs. Only sanctioned scrimmage hours as assigned by the Chapter will be used to determine the scrimmage credit. Summer League and other pre-season training sessions are not included when determining scrimmage credits, but they are counted toward the annual chapter training requirements. Members must stay current on assigning fees owed in order to be eligible to receive any earned scrimmage credit. Chapter dues must be paid prior to December 1st to receive credit.

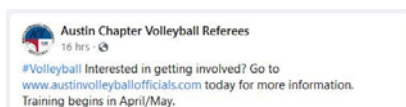

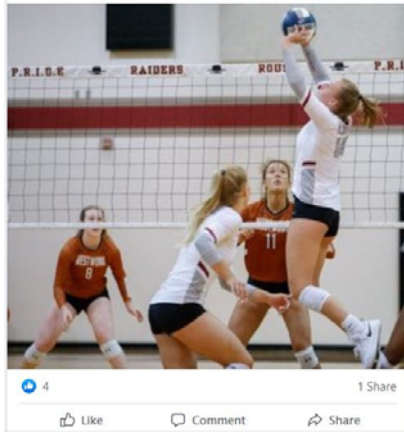
No more silly waistband restrictions!
