

TASO Membership Renewal DEADLINE EXTENDED!!!

The \$100 fee is the same as last year and includes your \$35 Continuing Education fee (which covers the cost of attending one or more of the following: Volleyball State Meeting, TASO Volleyball Regional Clinic or the Volleyball Online Clinic.) The renewal date, to avoid the the \$25 late fee, was **extended and will now be June 9, 2020**. (*Please remember that in order to participate in any ACV training/events you must be a current member of TASO*)

Unsure if you have already renewed TASO???

Currently, only 55 current members have submitted their TASO dues. To verify whether or not a member is current on their TASO membership, there are two options: 1) attempt to submit a renewal on the TASO site - if already paid it will notify the member, 2) in Arbiter, go to Profile and then Custom Fields - members who have paid will show "Yes" in the TASO membership field.

How does the CARES Act affect you:

Many of our officials rely on officiating income for various reasons. Historically, independent contractors have not been elligible to recieve unemployment benefits. However, sports officials now may be elligible under the recently passed CARES Act.

- The TASO Legal Team continues to review the CARES Act to identify potential benefits available to our members.
- The TASO Legislative Team has been working with the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) concerning the logistics in applying for benefits that may be available to independent contractor sports officials from the CARES Act.
