Exhibits basic understanding of:

R2 Specific

- Net faults/Center Line Violations
- Administration of substitutions and time outs

Level 3

- Working to be consistent with ball handling calls
- Good mechanics and proper signals
- Learning to recognize back row violations
- Learning to recognize rotational and positional faults

R2 Specific

- Recognizes positional faults with or without line-up card
- Becoming familiar with scoresheet to be able to correct errors
- Friendly interactions with table crew

Level 2

- Displays consistency with ball handling calls
- Excellent mechanics and signals
- Recognizes and confidently whistles back row faults
- Recognizes and confidently whistles rotational and positional faults
- Consistently scans line judges and centers with R2 prior to awarding points

R2 Specific

- Recognizes and confidently whistles positional faults with or without line-up card
- Able to quickly correct scoring errors
- Makes timely transitions into position and sees play develop through the net
- Provides discreet assistance with potential back row violations
- Professional and helpful interactions with table crew

Level 1

- Has mastered all areas identified in all other levels and
- Understands the "Art of Officiating"
- Inserts themselves in the match only when necessary
- Works well with partners and regularly seeks constructive comments via post-match debriefs
- Displays the ability to properly mentor others
- Consistently exhibits professional interactions w/coaches, players & spectators
- Professionally uses sanctions as needed
- Has consistent and appropriate match tempo
- Can support partner, even in the face of adversity

R2 Specific

- Willing to "make the call" on back row violations if partner does not recognize your discreet assistance
